It is agreed that upon default of any installment, the entire balance will become due, and service may be disconnected following ten (10) day written notice. The Justice Willow Springs Water Commission ("JWSWC") has the right to impose any penalties which were previously waived. Upon default, nothing herein shall constitute a waiver of the JWSWC right to collect the unpaid balance or prevent JWSWC from exercising its right to disconnect services because of such delinquency. The undersigned understands that in the event that the service is disconnected JWSWC may require a deposit to ensure payment of future bills and that a reconnection fee will be imposed before turning water back on. A \$50.00 fee will be collected for the turn off as well as a \$50.00 fee for turn on fee.

If you believe the terms of this agreement are unreasonable, **DO NOT SIGN**. If you sign this agreement, you acknowledge the amount due under the agreement, subject to the JWSWC right's to re-impose penalties. Signing this agreement does not affect your ability to pay for your current service. Allowing any bill for current service to become delinquent places you in default of this agreement.
